



2017 Safari Club International Hunter's Convention Exhibitor Show Planning Talking Points

- A. Starting with the 2017 convention GES will replace Freeman Co. as the SCI contracted show decorator and general service provider. Exhibiting companies who maintain a Freeman Co. account for any freight material will have to plan to switch services over to GES for their SCI freight package. GES information will be available on-site at the 2016 show.
- B. The Standard booth price will increase to \$2,550.00, a minor increase of \$50.00. The Prime booth pricing of \$2,850 will remain the same.
- C. All future credit card payments for convention related fees will have to be submitted on a payment form. Credit card payment information must be separate from any other documents in order for SCI to become PCI compliant. Payment forms containing credit card information will be destroyed once payment has been transacted.
- D. Annalisa Whitley no longer works with the exhibit team and has been replaced by Brenda DeVito as the primary administrative contact for all companies in the L – Z alphabet range. Annalisa will be missed by all and the entire convention team wishes her the best in her future endeavors.
- E. The 2017 show floor plan is now on-line; it remains the same layout as the 2016 plan. Please review the show floor lay out carefully when considering future booth placement. Submit your booth placement choices accordingly, but not too early as booth availability changes frequently during actual booth placement activity.
